#### Setup Requirements:

- A Motorola or Intermec Mobile Computer running Windows Mobile 5, 6.0 or 6.1

#### Download Instructions:

No additional files are required to perform this operation.

#### Installation Instructions:

- Tap Start, then Settings.
- Tap the *Connections* tab, then select the *Connections* icon.
- Tap the *Advanced* tab, then tap *Select Networks*.
- Ensure the top drop-down list reads *My ISP*, then tap the *Edit* button underneath that.
- Remove any existing connections by holding the stylus on them and tapping *Remove*.
- Tap the *New...* button.
- Name the connection after your service provider (eg Telstra or Vodafone).
- Change the Modem from *Cellular Line* to *Cellular Line (GPRS)*. Tap *Next*.
- Enter the *Access Point Name*. Here are the common ones:
  - Telstra: *Telstra.intetnet*
  - Optus: *Internet*
  - Vodafone: *vfinternet.au*
- Tap *Next*.
- Leave the *User Name*, *Password* and *Domain* fields blank.
- Click *Finish*.
- Reboot the device, and try connecting the to the internet.
