

Q : How do I restore my MC9090-G to its factory default state?

Setup Requirements:

- An SD or MMC Card (with at least 64MB capacity)
- A PC with access to a Card Reader
- A small Philips head screw driver
- A MC9090-G Mobile Computer running Windows Mobile 5.

Download Instructions:

You should have already downloaded the files required to factory restore your MC9090-G. If not, please use the link provided below to do so.

Installation Instructions:

- Extract all files contained within the Restore.zip file to the root directory of the SD or MMC Card.
- Remove the keyboard using the two Phillips head screws at the top of the keyboard.
- Insert the SD or MMC Card, making sure it clicks in properly.
- Replace the keyboard (do not replace screws at this point).
- Remove the battery to the first stop point (press the release buttons at the bottom left and right hand sides)..
- Hold down the trigger and press Power. Continue to hold the trigger until the MC9090 screen appears.
- Re-insert the battery; An update screen will then appear. Wait for the update to complete and the unit to reboot..
- Once rebooted, remove the SD or MMC Card, replace the keypad and reinsert the screws.
- Allow time for the system to boot up again.
